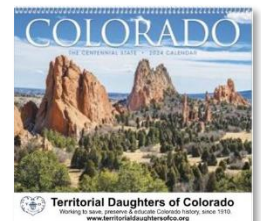

**Colorado Historical November events:** Nov. 13, 1869, the Denver Gas Company incorporates in Denver. Nov. 15, 1872, Fairplay incorporates. Nov. 1, 1876, The Colorado General Assembly convenes for the first time. Nov. 8, 1879, Buena Vista incorporates. Nov. 8, Denver is made the permanent capital of the state, by a state referendum. Nov. 24, 1884, Brush incorporates. Nov. 15, 1885, Greeley, Evans, and Erie incorporate. Greeley is the seat of Weld County. Nov. 8, 1887 John Henry "Doc" Holiday dies in Glenwood Springs at the age of 36. Nov. 10, 1902, Cortz incorporates. Nov. 15, 1902, after a long court battle Arapahoe County is split into three new counties: The City & County of Denver, South Arapahoe County and Adams County. Nov. 5, 1904, Edgewater incorporates. Nov. 2, 1916, Flagler incorporates. Nov 15, 1972, Denver withdraws its offer to host the 1976 Winter Olympics. Nov. 26, 1990, The US Army transfers the Pinon Canyon Maneuver site to Comanche National Grassland. Nov. 6, 2007, Castle Pines North incorporates.
