**Colorado Historical Bits for May:**

May 29, 1860; William Gilpin [appointed 1<sup>st</sup> Governor of Territory of Colorado, by Pres. Abraham Lincoln] arrives in Denver City.

May 2, 1870; Episcopal Bishop George Maxwell Randall begins construction of the *Territorial School of Mines* at Golden City. (Officially established 1874)

May 14, 1890; Town of Cheyenne Wells incorporates.

May 19, 1892; Town of Creede incorporates.

May 5, 1903; Town of Fletcher incorporates [changed name to Town of Aurora, March 4, 1907].

May 9, 1903; Town of Englewood incorporates.

May 5, 1909; Jackson County is created from the western portion of Larimer County.
