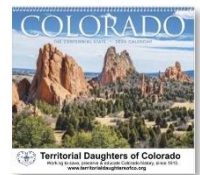


Colorado Historical Tidbits: August 12, 1878; Alamosa incorporates. August 25, 1900; Fowler incorporates. August 24, 1904; Arvada incorporates. August 18, 1906; Bayfield incorporates. August 27, 1942; The Granada War Relocation Center (Camp Amache) opens. August 1948; Construction begins on the Valley Highway in Denver. August 3, 1950; President Truman abolishes the Holy Cross & Wheeler National Monuments. Both areas of land revert to the National Forests in those area. August 28, 1950; President Truman issues Public Land Order, creating Manti-La Sal National Forest. August 3, 1960; two climbers are the first to surmount The Diamond on the east face of Long's Peak. August 20, 1969; President Nixon establishes the Florissant Fossil Beds National Monument. August 1, 1974; Highway I-80S is renamed I-76. August 1, 1978; US Olympic Committee moves into headquarters in Colorado Springs. August 1979; Avon incorporates. August 10, 1993; Pope John Paul II visits Colorado for World Youth Day. August 2007; The Anschutz Medical Campus of UC Denver opens. August 10, 2020; Humans ignite the Grizzly Creek Fire in Glenwood Canyon. August 13, 2020; Cameron Peak Fire ignites, SW of Redfeather Lakes. August 14, 2020; Humans ignite the Williams Fork Fire, SW of Fraser.
